- → Our CAREER PREPARATION CENTER, the largest of these magnet schools, provides sixteen specialized and technical programs for juniors and seniors, ranging from culinary arts to computer information systems.
- → The MACOMB MATHEMATICS SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY CENTER (MMSTC), includes both the MMSTC High School and Middle School. MMSTC is a consortium of ten school districts, offers an interdisciplinary, accelerated program of studies involving students in collaborative projects that prepare students for careers in science and mathematics.

# CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTWS

A minimum of twenty-two and one half (22.5) credits is required for graduation. Classes are semesterized and students may earn a maximum of six credits per year in twelve classes.
